# Mexico Announces Authorized Entry Points for Textile Products 2001

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#### Report Highlights:

**On August 9, 2001, Mexico announced the Twenty First Resolution of Modifications to the Miscellaneous Resolution of Foreign Trade for 2000 and its annex 10 and 21. The announcement refers to the names of six authorized ports of entry for textiles' products (Chapters 50 to 63 of HTS). These authorized ports are added to the list announced on July 30, 2001. The resolution will be enforced on August 20, 2001.**

**Introduction:** This report summarizes an official resolution published in Mexico's "*Diario Oficial*" (Federal Register) on August 9, 2001.

**FAS/Mexico's Executive Summary:** Mexico's Treasury (SHCP) published in the "*Diario Oficial*" (Federal Register) the Twentieth First Resolution of Modifications to the Miscellaneous Resolution of Foreign Trade for 2000 and its annex 10 and 21. This resolution modifies the announcement of Monday, July 30, 2001 published also in the *Diario Oficial*, which limited ports of entry for textiles. This resolution adds six more border crossing points to the six announced on July 30, 2001 (see the complete list below). The announcement also indicates it will be enforced on August 20, 2001. It should be noted that the action limiting points of entry for textiles was suspended until Customs renewed its policy.

The resolution affects all products within HTS chapters 50 and 63. The ports of entry were limited to three sea ports, one airport, seven ports on the Mexican/Texas border and one border on the Mexican/Guatemala border. These eligible ports are as follow:

1. Ciudad Juarez, Chihuahua/El Paso, TX
2. Manzanillo, Colima/Pacific Coast Port
3. Matamoros, Tamaulipas/Brownsville, TX
4. Mexico City/Juarez Airport
5. Mexico City (Pantaco)
6. Nuevo Laredo, Tamaulipas/Laredo, TX
7. Progreso, Tamaulipas/McAllen, TX
8. Ciudad Hidalgo, Chiapas/Guatemala
9. Tijuana, Baja California/San Ysidro, CA
10. Veracruz, Veracruz/Gulf of Mexico Coast Port
11. Colombia, Nuevo Leon/Laredo TX
12. Cancun, Quintana Roo/Caribbean Coast Port

**FAS/Mexico's Comment:** This resolution was published due to pressure from Mexican textile producers that complained about cheap Asian textiles entering Mexico illegally. To combat this illegal trade, the idea is to limit the number of ports of entry. Raw cotton should not be affected since the majority of cotton enters Mexico through the approved ports of entry. According to CANAITEX (the Mexican Textile Chamber) approximately 91 percent of the Mexican textile and raw cotton imports enter Mexico through the approved ports of entry. At this time, there is no indication that this Customs decree will disrupt US cotton trade.
