Monthly Beans and Pulses Trade Report for November 2001.

During the month of November, Burma exported 46,831 metric tons of Beans and Pulses and 964 metric tons of Beans and Pulses through Border Trade.

Border Trade.

Myanma Agricultural Produce Trading (MAPT), an agency of the Ministry of Commerce exported a total of 964 metric tons of Beans and Pulses through Border trade.

A. 399 metric tons of Mung beans

556 metric tons of Matpe, sold through Kawthaung, a total of 955 metric tons of beans and pulses destined for Thailand. Prevailing market price in Ra Naung for Matpe was US\$330 per metric ton and Mung beans (Pedesein) at US\$ 224 per metric ton.

B.9 metric tons of Soya beans sold through Tamu, a total of 9 metric tons of beans and pulses destined for India

Export prices set for beans and pulses by Price Appraisal Committee that met on Nov.21, 2001 are:

Butter Beans (Lima beans)Sales to U.S

Confirmed Trade Sources said that a U.S company named PAC LINK bought 40 metric tons of Butter beans (Lima beans) at US\$ 148 per metric ton from Myanmar Agriculture Produce Trading (MAPT).

In November ,Toor Whole(Pigeon pea) comprises 33 percent, Black Matpe 34 percent and Mung bean comprises 27 percent of the total beans and pulses export. The major destination was India. 79 percent of the total beans and pulses were exported to India.

Beans and Pulses prices for Matpe and Mung beans are quite depressed in the domestic market as most of the traders are waiting for the new crop to enter into the market. The new crop for Mung beans will be harvested round about end of December and Matpe will be about Feb.in the Lower Burma

Japanese Market.

Japan exported 200 metric tons of Butter Beans (Lima beans) in November.
