I. MARKET OVERVIEW

A. Demographic Summary

UK Jewish Population

The exact size and trend of the UK's Jewish population is difficult to accurately identify. In 2001, the official national census included religious indicators for the first time. Based on these statistics (at http://www.statistics.gov.uk/census2001/profiles/uk.asp), there are 266,740 people of Jewish religion in the UK. However, census representatives believe this figure is below the actual number. In addition, this estimate does not precisely indicate the number of regular kosher consumers in the UK, as not all Jews are regular kosher consumers and some may only purchase kosher food for certain holidays.

Along with the census data, all estimates of British Jewry are between 250,000 and 300,000, and there is an agreed trend showing declining numbers. A study by Professor Geoffrey Alderman reports around 300,000 "self-identifying" British Jews, whose numbers are shrinking at the rate of one percent per year due to emigration, assimilation and smaller family sizes. Additionally, other statistics published by Schmool and Cohen, available through the Board of Deputies of British Jews, indicate the following trend in the UK Jewish population since 1986:

Regional Populations

London is home to Europe's second largest Jewish community, with an estimated 200,000 Jews. London's Jewish community is made up of Sephardim (originally from Mediterranean areas), German and Eastern European Jews. These groups began arriving in the 1890s and settled in London's East End. Since World War II, the Jewish community has moved to the London suburbs and major centers have developed in Hendon, Golder's Green, Brent Cross and Finchley. There are also sizeable communities in the outer London areas of Kenton, Edgware, Stanmore, Bushey, Borehamwood and Radlett.

Manchester is the UK's second largest community of British Jews. In addition, there are sizable communities in Leeds, Glasgow, Gateshead, Brighton, Birmingham, Liverpool and Southend. In the past decade, these communities have declined at a greater rate than those in London and the SouthEast.

Non-Traditional Kosher Consumers

Other possible kosher consumers in the UK are Muslims, vegetarians and lactose intolerants. Again, there is discrepancy in reported figures for the UK's Muslim population. According to the 2001 national census, there are approximately 1.59 million Muslims in the UK and it is reported to be a community that is growing

(http://www.statistics.gov.uk/census2001/profiles/uk.asp). Some Muslims find it acceptable to consume kosher food.

With respect to vegetarians, trade sources report that UK vegetarians look for kosher food, as they know that they can trust the "parve" labeling to guarantee no meat or dairy content. The UK's Vegetarian Society reports around 3 million vegetarians in the UK, which is 5 percent of the adult population (http://www.vegsoc.org/newveg/). In the last ten years, the number of vegetarians in the UK has more than doubled.

B. Prospects for U.S. Kosher Product Entry

Target Areas

Assuming that the U.S. kosher product you wish to export has a sole target audience of British Jews, it can be derived from the above demographic overview that the largest market for U.S. products in the UK lies predominately in the Northern London area. U.S. exporters are advised to visit this area and network with UK importers, retailers and foodservice operators — contacts are provided at the back of this report.

Depending on a product's price, consumer appeal and competition, there are opportunities for U.S. kosher products in both the small independent retailers and mainstream supermarkets. According to industry contacts, the number of small independent retailers has decreased by approximately 15 percent since 1988, particularly in communities outside Northern London. According to one contact, an increase in young British Jews leaving the family business or leaving their original community is speculated to have caused this trend. Therefore, the future growth of kosher food sales appears to be in supermarkets.

Relationship with Importers

As most U.S. products are subject to import duty, price is an important concern. For all avenues of distribution, it is beneficial to work through an importer who can assist with local food safety and labeling laws, and any other required trading standards legislation. UK supermarket chains are notoriously difficult to develop a relationship with; therefore, it is important to find an importer with the appropriate contacts to market your product.

Target Products

Given the rigorous EU requirements for meat, and the very high tariffs on baked goods, the best prospects for U.S. products are quality shelf-stable products that are not yet available as kosher in the UK, or can compete on price or some other marketing advantage. The best chance for success is with a product that is desirable for the mainstream market as well as the kosher market.

In general, UK consumers of kosher products follow the mainstream UK consumer trends towards convenience products, healthy alternatives, organic products, specialty items and ethnic foods. As a result, there are market opportunities for snack foods, cookies, sauces, dips, breakfast cereals, soft drinks and other ambient grocery items that would appeal to a sophisticated consumer. There is also a market for kosher wines, particularly for dry varieties that are showing more growth than the sweet dessert wines.

Opportunities also exist for U.S. products that can be specially formulated or designed to specifications, to meet taste requirements for the particular products. Some Israeli manufacturers now export such products to the UK.

C. Certification and Import Requirements

Certification, Product Labeling

Major U.S. kosher certification symbols are accepted in the UK, with the Union of Orthodox Jewish Congregations of America (OU) symbol probably being the most familiar to UK consumers. Certification acceptance varies with the individual consumer and local UK symbols have a stronger following. The main UK authorities are the London Beth Din; Kedassia, The Joint Kashrus Committee of England; and the Manchester Beth Din. Their contact details are at the end of this report. The London Beth Din is the most well known, encompassing licensing of over 70 restaurants, hotels and bakeries, as well as certification of almost 700 factories worldwide (http://www.kosher.org.uk/).

According to the London Beth Din Kashrut Division, "...sadly, the limited size of the UK Jewish population is such that the vast majority of UK manufacturers are uninterested in the placing of any kosher logo on their products." It can therefore be difficult with some UK products to ascertain if it is permitted as kosher. This can give U.S. kosher products an advantage in the UK market to appeal to the mass market and to have a kosher following.

Importation Regulations

Kosher products are not subject to additional UK food laws that differ from their non-kosher counterparts. For further information, please see the FAS report covering UK import regulations and local labeling/ingredient law entitled, "Food and Agricultural Import Regulations" (Report Number UK1030 at

http://www.fas.usda.gov/gainfiles/200108/120681479.pdf). Currently, U.S. poultry is not permitted to enter the EU and in general, it is difficult to export red meat, which requires EU certification. Products with a high sugar content and/or flour/starch content are liable for very high import duties, ranging between 30 and 70 percent.

D. Promotion of Kosher Products in UK

Onsite Marketing

Once a product is listed with UK retailers, marketing activities such as in-store promotions and fliers can be arranged and may be particularly desirable around key holiday times. If arrangements are made through an importer, the promotion of the product(s) becomes the importer's responsibility.


Website, Publication Sources

It is considered that the most widely read UK publication for placing advertisements is the London-based Jewish Chronicle, located at http://www.jchron.co.uk. Another advertising

option is the website http://www.jewish.co.uk, an on-line advertising forum. There is also the publication, entitled "The Really Jewish Food Guide," which is published by the London Beth Din and aims to provide reliable guidance on local products to both natives and tourists. It would be beneficial to have your product approved by the Beth Din and listed in this booklet, which is regarded as essential for Anglo-kosher consumers.

II. MARKET SECTORS

Figure I below illustrates the distribution system for food products from the U.S. to the UK market.



A. Retail

Stores

Many kosher products are sold at the retail level through small independent stores located in the heart of Jewish communities. These stores obtain their products from UK manufacturers, UK importers, or directly from the United States or a competitor country (such as Israel, a major kosher product supplier). Among the older generation, customer loyalty is strong and shopping preferences tend to be conservative. Their grocery shopping is done primarily at local neighborhood stores. Young, modern Jewish consumers who are kosher-observant are more likely to shop at a variety of shops and supermarkets, looking for exciting mainstream products now available as kosher.

The remaining kosher retail sales are through the large UK supermarkets. These are a considerable force in mainstream UK retailing with the top ten chains accounting for around 70 percent of all UK retail grocery sales. Major UK retail chains have a number of stores that include kosher food sections. To illustrate, Tesco—the UK's largest retailer—has approximately 20 percent of its stores with kosher sections. Many other mainstream products throughout the store are also kosher. The location of stores that carry kosher product lines is determined by the demand of the local population.

Consumer Preference

UK retailers tend to experience an increase in ethnic kosher product sales during major Jewish holidays, particularly at Passover. This represents a strong opportunity for imports of U.S. kosher-for-Passover products.

Depending upon the product and the supplier's plans for that product, the supplier may lobby UK retailers to locate the product outside the dedicated kosher section. A proportion of the UK population believes that kosher food is only to be eaten by Jews. Therefore, if the product has universal appeal, its sale may be limited if it is located only within the kosher section.

B. Hotel and Restaurant Industry (HRI) / Food Service

Catering, Restaurant Market

There is a small market for kosher meals in branches of UK foodservice. For most mainstream operators, preparing kosher products on-site is not cost-effective. Generally, kosher meals are brought in frozen from specialized suppliers. Frozen meals provided by licensed suppliers are usually in specialized protective plastic or foil containers. They are labeled, taped with tamper-proof seals and coded with kosher license details that meet kosher, food hygiene and labeling regulations. These meals are supplied to hospitals, schools, restaurants and hotels for functions with kosher-observant guests.

There are approximately 15 to 20 kosher restaurants in the UK, with the majority located in London. To date, kosher food has not attracted the interest shown in other ethnic cuisines. This is thought to be attributable to its specialized nature and associated added costs to the consumer.

Sources of Opportunity

Opportunities for U.S. foodservice products and food ingredients for catering can be found through contact with the specialist kosher foodservice manufacturers shown in the HRI/Foodservice section at the end of this report and through contact with the UK kosher restaurants. However, it is common for these establishments to source products through UK importers, and so they remain the most important contacts to make.

A list of the major UK kosher caterers can be found at the end of this report.
