Report Highlights:

On December 29, 2020 Korea issued its annual list of adjustment tariffs and voluntary tariff rate quotas (TRQs) for certain agricultural, forestry and fishery products, effective through calendar year 2021. Korea's 2021 tariff adjustments were relatively unchanged from the previous year; however, expanded TRQ's for a handful of agricultural commodities will increase opportunities for U.S. agricultural exports, particularly in feed grains and food ingredients.

Executive Summary:

Adjustment Tariffs & Voluntary TRQs Announced for 2021

On December 29, 2020, the Ministry of Economy and Finance (MOEF) announced an updated list of adjustment tariffs (Table I) and voluntary tariff rate quotas (TRQs) for certain agricultural, forestry and fishery products (Table II) that are effective through calendar year 2021. These adjustment tariffs and TRQs are part of a special program run by MOEF to assist domestic industries. According to the Ministry, the voluntary TRQs for agricultural commodities are intended to assist the domestic livestock industry by reducing input costs. As such, these TRQs apply mainly to feed grains.

In 2021, MOEF will maintain adjustment tariffs on 13 selected agricultural and fishery items. The items included are the same as those managed in 2020. Tariffs are set in consideration of price differences between domestic and imported goods, market share, and tariff differentials within similar products. The continued 2021 tariffs listed in Table 1 (parboiled rice, Chinese vermicelli, oak mushroom, plywood, frozen squid, and frozen Alaskan Pollack) are justified by MOEF's determination that competing domestic industries continue to need protection.

MOEF also manages 2021 voluntary TRQs with the goal of achieving domestic price stabilization, improve industrial competitiveness, and reduced costs for domestic livestock producers. The Korean government will continue its support for the feed grain complex (16 commodities), such as maize (corn), soymeal, barley, and oats. Four commodities received additional volume allocations within the 2021 quota, including Manioc chips, Maize for feed, Sugar containing added flavor or color, and Other preparations for animal feed. Conversely, a TRQ for Wheat bran was removed from this year's voluntary list. [The Korean language announcement can be found here: Press Release for 2020 Adjustment and Voluntary TRQs](#)
