Report Highlights:

Taiwan published its annual list of food and agriculture imports receiving enhanced border inspection in 2024. U.S. fresh cherries are the only U.S.-origin item on the list. This announcement is effective from January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024.

General Information

The Taiwan Food and Drug Administration (TFDA) published its annual list of food and agriculture products that will receive enhanced border inspection in 2024. U.S fresh cherries (HS code: 0809.29.00.00.0) are the only U.S.-origin item on the list. TFDA cites pesticide residue violations in 2023 as the reason for the enhanced inspection protocol.

TFDA defines enhanced inspection as a border inspection rate of 20 to 50 percent, increased from the baseline rate of two to ten percent.

TFDA's announcement is effective from January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024. The full notice can be [found here](#) (Chinese only).
