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South Africa, Republic of Promotion Opportunities Annual Report 2007

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Report Highlights:

This report provide details of upcoming 2008 trade events in Southern Africa, and other marketing opportunities and events USDA FAS/AgPretoria is planning on organizing in support of U.S. companies who are interested in entering or increasing sales within the Southern Africa market. Post believes that, in addition to South Africa, Angola shows the greatest opportunity for growth for U.S. Agricultural exports out of the ten countries that AgPretoria cover in Southern Africa. In 2006, the United States exported approximately \$170 million of agricultural, fish and forestry products to South Africa. Intermediate agricultural products such as planting seeds are an important export to South Africa. A variety of high-value products such as almonds, cultivated ginseng root, canned salmon, Kentucky bourbon, frozen food preparations, and sauces have shown consistent growth over the last five years and represent important opportunities for U.S. exporters. Over the past five years, the United States has exported an average of \$65.5 million per year of agricultural fish and forestry products to Angola.
