During the month of April, Burma exported 124,991 metric tons of Beans and Pulses and 2,061 metric tons of Beans and Pulses through Border Trade.

A. 250 metric tons of Chick peas, a total of 250 metric tons of beans and pulses exported to Bangladesh.

B. 112 metric tons of Toor whole, a total of 112 metric tons of beans and pulses exported to Belgium.

Border Trade.

Myanma Agricultural Produce Trading (MAPT), an agency of the Ministry of Commerce, exported a total of 2,061 metric tons of Beans and Pulses through Border trade.

A. 955 metric tons of Cow pea (white) beans and

1,044 metric tons of Bamboo beans, sold through Muse, a total of 1,999 metric tons of beans and pulses destined for China.

B. 53 metric tons of Cow pea (Bocate) sold through Kaw Thaung, a total of 53 metric tons of beans and pulses destined for (Ra Naung)Thailand.

C. 9 metric tons of Soya beans sold through Tamu, a total of 9 metric tons of beans and pulses destined for India.

In May, Toor Whole(Pigeon pea) comprised 52 percent, Black Matpe 25 percent and Mung bean comprised 11 percent of the total beans and pulses exports. The major destination was India; 93 percent of the total beans and pulses were exported to India.
