Report Highlights:

Burma exported 69,531 metric tons of beans and pulses in October 2001. The major destination was India.

Monthly Beans and Pulses Trade Report for October 2001.

During the month of October, Burma exported 69,531 metric tons of Beans and Pulses and metric tons of Beans and Pulses through Border Trade.

Border Trade.

Myanma Agricultural Produce Trading (MAPT), an agency of the Ministry of Commerce exported a total of 2,733 metric tons of Beans and Pulses through Border trade.

A. 1,956 metric tons of Soya beans, sold through Muse, a total of 1,956 metric tons of beans and pulses destined for China.

B. 590 metric tons of Mung beans

187 metric tons of Matpe, sold through Kaw Thaung, a total of 777 metric tons of beans and pulses destined for(Ra Naung) Thailand. Prevailing market price in Ra Naung for Matpe was Bhat 19 per kilo and Mung beans (Pedesein) at Bhat 14 per kilo.

Export prices set for beans and pulses by Price Appraisal Committee that met on Oct.12, 2001 are:

Matpe (FAQ)* US\$ 300 per metric ton
Matpe (SQ)** US\$ 370 per metric ton
Pedesein (Mung beans) (Big) US\$ 330 per metric ton(size 3.25 mm & above)
Butter Beans (FAQ) US\$ 200 per metric ton
Pesingon (Toor whole) (FAQ) US\$ 220 per metric ton

In October, Toor Whole(Pigeon pea) comprises 50 percent, Black Matpe 25 percent and Mung bean comprises 14 percent of the total beans and pulses export. The major destination was India. 91 percent of the total beans and pulses were exported to India.

Japanese Market.

Compared to a previous month it was interesting to note that there was an increase of 554 percent in beans and pulses export to Japan including Butter beans (Lima beans)compared to a previous month.
