Report Highlights:

On March 11, 2025, the General Department of Customs and Excise of Cambodia announced the import ban on frozen pork offal would end on March 12, 2025. Cambodia placed a temporary ban on several types of Frozen offal in March 2024, the ban on all other affected products was lifted in September 2024.

Summary

On March 11, 2025, the General Department of Customs and Excise (GDCE) of Cambodia announced the temporary import ban on frozen pork offal would end on March 12, 2025. The two impacted HS Codes are 0206.41.00 and 0206.49.00. The initial temporary ban was effective March 12, 2024 to September 12, 2024 and included bans on frozen offal of bovines, poultry and other animals except for fish. The bans on all other affected products, except for frozen pork offal, were allowed to expire on September 12, 2024 (See GAIN Report: <u>Cambodia Extends Frozen Pork Offal Ban</u>).

Notice from the GDCE:

Per the Ministry of Commerce's Letter (0744) dated March 11, 2025, the General Department of Customs and Excise of Cambodia would like to inform the public and all relevant stakeholders that the temporary ban on the import of two tariff lines of frozen pork offal (HS Codes 0206.41.00 and 0206.49.00) will expire on March 12, 2025, as stated in a joint notice by the Ministry of Commerce and Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries dated September 12, 2024.

Effective March 13, 2025, any imports of frozen pork offal above will resume in compliance with Subregulation No. 370 on the Implementation of the List of Prohibited and Restricted Goods dated December 28, 2023.
