Report Highlights:

On April 3, 2020, the Eurasian Economic Commission (EEC), which is the regulatory body of the Armenia-Belarus-Kazakhstan-Kyrgyzstan-Russia Eurasian Economic Union (EAEU), issued EEC Council Decision No. 33, introducing a temporary exemption from import duties for critical food products, such as potatoes, onions, garlic, cabbages, rice, rye, buckwheat, etc., as part of the EAEU coronavirus pandemic response. The measure, which comes into effect on April 18, 2020, will apply to products imported as of April 1, 2020, and last through June 30, 2020. This report contains an unofficial English translation of the measure.

General Information

On April 3, 2020, the Eurasian Economic Commission (EEC), which is the regulatory body of the Armenia-Belarus-Kazakhstan-Kyrgyzstan-Russia Eurasian Economic Union¹ (EAEU), issued EEC Council Decision No. 33 (in Russian) introducing a temporary exemption from import duties for critical food products, such as potatoes, onions, garlic, cabbages, rice, rye, buckwheat, etc. The measure will come into effect on April 18, 2020, apply to products imported as of April 1, 2020, and last through June 30, 2020.

The measure, introduced as part of the EAEU coronavirus pandemic response, follows shortly an earlier EAEU decision to ban exports of some food products. As a result, the following food items are now both exempt from the EAEU import duties and banned for export from the EAEU:

On Amending Some Decisions of the Customs Union Commission and on Approving the List of Goods of Critical Imports

In accordance with Articles 43 and 45 of the Treaty on the Eurasian Economic Union of May 29, 2014, paragraphs 16 and 18 of Regulation on the Eurasian Economic Commission (Annex No. 1 to the Treaty on the Eurasian Economic Union of May 29, 2014), paragraphs 7 and 16 of the Attachment No. 1 to the Rules of Procedure of the Eurasian Economic Commission, approved by Decision of the Supreme Eurasian Economic Council No. 98 of December 23, 2014, the Council of the Eurasian Economic Commission **has resolved**:

1. Item 7 of Decision of the Customs Union Commission No. 130 of November 27, 2009 "On the Unified Customs-Tariff Regulation in the Eurasian Economic Union" shall be supplemented with item 7.1.33 as follows:

"7.1.33. Goods imported into the customs territory of the Union, included in the list of critical imports, approved by Decision of the Council of the Eurasian Economic Commission No. 33 of April 3, 2020.

The specified exemption is granted subject to registration of a declaration of goods for their placement under the customs procedure for release for domestic consumption through June 30, 2020".

2. In item 15 of the Procedure for the application of exemption from customs duties when importing certain categories of goods into the unified customs territory of the Customs Union, approved by Decision of the Customs Union Commission No. 728 of July 15, 2011, the numbers "7.1.32" shall be replaced with the numbers "7.1.33".

3. To approve the attached list of good of critical imports.

4. The Present Decision shall take effect after 10 calendar days from the date of its official publication and apply to operations as of April 1, 2020.
