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Report Highlights:

The 2024 Food and Agriculture Import Regulations and Standards (FAIRS) Export Certificate Report for Turkiye lists the major export certificates and other requirements expected by the Turkish government for food and agricultural products exports to Turkiye. This report should be read in coordination with the 2024 FAIRS Annual Country Report for Turkiye, which outlines specific requirements for food and agricultural product imports into Turkiye and can be accessed on the FAS Global Agricultural Information Network website at <https://gain.fas.usda.gov/#/search>.

Executive Summary:

This report provides information on export certificates that the Turkish government requires. The Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry (MinAF) is the responsible authority for preparing and implementing policy and legislation related to food and agricultural product safety. Products imported into Türkiye must meet existing legislation requirements and must be accompanied by the proper certificates at the port of arrival. MinAF identifies food and agricultural products which must be accompanied by an “original certificate” attesting to the safety of animal and plant health of the product in question.

In 2024, MinAF is requiring five new modal Veterinary Health Certificates for animals and products, which can be found in Section I of this report. The products that require plant or veterinary health certificates are listed in the appendices of this report. Exporters should be in close communication with their importer in Türkiye to confirm the latest requirements and prevent detainment or rejection of cargo.

Section II: Specific Attestations Required on Export Certificate(s)

Phytosanitary Certificate:

A Phytosanitary Certificate is required for unprocessed agricultural products such as cotton, oilseeds, grains, nuts, wood products, etc. It should be issued by the relevant competent plant protection authority of the producing or exporting country according to the International Standards for Phytosanitary Measures (ISPM)-12 rules. In the United States, the USDA Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS) is the plant protection competent authority at the federal level which is responsible for issuing phytosanitary certificates for international trade. Special conditions are given in Annex 4 of the Plant Quarantine Regulation, which is available in Turkish [here](#) and in English [here](#).

Depending on the plant and plant product, any information about special conditions required by Annex-4 of the Plant Quarantine Regulation should be provided clearly or referred to the relevant articles in the phytosanitary certificate's Additional Declaration section. Additional Declarations may also be given separately where needed. In that case, the authority that issues the phytosanitary certificate must refer to the original phytosanitary certificate and sign/stamp it.

According to the Turkish Plant Quarantine Regulation, the phytosanitary certificate must be issued, at most, 14 days prior to the shipment date. Additionally, for certificates on which the inspection date and the date of issue are separately stated, the period between the inspection date and the shipment date

cannot exceed 14 days. The inspection date of the product must be stated on the phytosanitary certificate issued after the shipment date.

APHIS generally requires that shipments must be exported within 14 days of inspection. Phytosanitary certificates issued before departure do not have to include an inspection date. If phytosanitary certificates cannot be obtained before departure, the inspection date must be included as an Additional Declaration. Exporters should take note that this regulation differs from EU regulations, which require that a commodity depart a country within 14 days of issuance of a phytosanitary certificate, not the inspection date.

There should not be any erasure or crossed out text on the phytosanitary certificate. Each correction made on a certificate should be approved and signed by the relevant competent authority.

Certificate of Free Sale/Health Certificate:

A Certificate of Free Sale/Health Certificate is required for processed food and feed of plant origin, such as canned food, pet food of plant origin, vegetable juices, energy drinks, alcoholic beverages, etc., and for materials and articles which are intended to come into contact with food (food contact materials).

The Certificate of Free Sale/Health Certificate should have one of the following statements:

- 1) “Product is sold and traded freely in the U.S.,”
- 2) “Product is produced in compliance with the legislation of the U.S.,”
- 3) “Product does not possess any risk to human and/or animal health,”
- 4) “Product does not possess any risk in the aspect of food and/or feed safety,”
- 5) “Test results of product are in compliance with legislation,” or
- 6) “Product is fit for contact with food.”

If a product requires both quarantine and food/feed safety controls and is accompanied by a phytosanitary certificate, a Certificate of Free Sale/Health Certificate is not required for the product in question.

Certificates of Free Sale/Health Certificates should be issued on behalf of the producer or exporter and must be endorsed by the competent authority of the origin or exporting country.

For food products, the FDA provides written certification for exports in the form of certificates and lists of eligible exporters for specific products or destinations. Export certificates include Certificate to a Foreign Government, Certificate of Exportability, Certificate of Free Sale, and health certificates for collagen and gelatin for products intended for export to the European Union. MinAF accepts FDA’s certificates. For more information on FDA-issued export certificates, visit the FDA website for [Food Export Certificates](#).

In addition, MinAF publishes the list of U.S. state or local certifying competent authorities which issue Certificates of Free Sale/Health Certificates recognized by MinAF for food and feed of plant and plant origin from the United States. The list is available [here](#) in Turkish. **Error! Hyperlink reference not valid.** The current list of competent authorities recognized for the United States is given in APPENDIX-III of this report. The USDA/FAS Office of Agricultural Affairs at the U.S. Embassy in Ankara may need to provide Turkish officials with a document confirming the authority of the local or federal certifier if the entity is not already included on the MinAF’s preapproved list.

Certificate of Age for Alcohol:

A copy of the Certificate of Age for products which require aging (such as whiskey) is submitted to the MinAF Food Safety Information System at the time of the shipment-notification of the product. The original copy of this certificate should be supplied at the time of import.

Certificate of Origin:

A Certificate of Origin is also required for plant and plant-origin products. If the origin is not indicated in the Certificate of Free Sale/Health Certificate, MinAF accepts the address of the manufacturer as the origin of the product. If there is no information related to the origin of the product, then Certificate of Origin issued by the competent authority must be provided.

Food Contact Material:

For materials and articles which are intended to come into contact with food, if there is no competent authority issuing a Certificate of Free Sale/Health Certificate, then, a declaration from the producer is sufficient to meet Turkiye's requirement. This declaration should contain information such as the name and amount of product, lot number, the name and address of the producer, and the statement "product is fit for contact with foods."

Manufacturer Certificate:

MinAF requires the foreign competent authority to issue and sign a Manufacturer Certificate for imports of plant protection products (PPPs). U.S. Chambers of Commerce and State Departments of Agriculture are authorized to sign the certificates for PPPs from the United States. MinAF has identified the template of this Certificate, and no other format is allowed. Please find detailed information about the Manufacturer Certificate and its template [here](#).

Veterinary Health Certificates:

Veterinary Health Certificates are required for animal and animal origin products such as livestock, gelatin, collagen, hides and skins, dairy products, etc. Certificates under the name of "Health Certificate," "Veterinary Health Certificate," or "Origin and Veterinary Health Certificate," guaranteeing animal and public health status are accepted as Veterinary Health Certificates by MinAF.

A sample Veterinary Health Certificate will be provided at the time of receiving a Control Certificate (please see Section VI, Section IX and Section X of Turkiye's import procedures in the 2024 FAIRS Annual Country Report for Turkiye, which is accessible [here](#)). The content of a sample Veterinary Health Certificate should be the same as the official Veterinary Health Certificate, however, it may or may not contain attestation(s).

MinAF outlines a format for Veterinary Health Certificates for certain animal/animal-origin products. These formats are available on MinAF's [website](#) in Turkish. Please review the sample Veterinary Health Certificates for certain products in the links given in APPENDIX-IV of this report.

It is important to provide Veterinary Health Certificates with exactly the same content and format if the format is identified for the product by MinAF. If the format is not identified for the product in question, then the Veterinary Health Certificate should contain information such as:

- the name of the exporting country/region,

- the competent authority,
- the exporter,
- the importer,
- the country of origin,
- the species of animal from which the product is derived/produced,
- the description and amount of product,
- information related to transport, and,
- if it is for human consumption, including the statement “fit for human consumption”,
- for products not for human consumption, the intended use must be indicated, such as “for feed use,” “for soap industry”, etc., and
- depending on the type of product, statements related to animal and/or public health.

MinAF publishes a “List of Banned Countries & Substances Due to Animal Diseases” for animal and animal products on their [website](#) in Turkish. Some animal products on this list are only allowed to be imported after special treatment to eliminate risk(s), and the Veterinary Health Certificate should contain a detailed description of this treatment as an additional declaration. Additional declarations may also be given separately. In that case, the authority that issues the Veterinary Health Certificate must refer to the original Veterinary Health Certificate and sign/stamp it.

Certificate of Origin:

A Certificate of Origin is also required for animal and animal-origin products to support the product’s health status, with respect to the animal diseases of the producing or exporting country, if the origin is not indicated in the Veterinary Health Certificate.

Section III: Government Certificate Legal Entry Requirements

Certificate of Free Sale/Health Certificate:

A Certificate of Free Sale/Health Certificate, unless indicated otherwise, is valid for one year, but may not exceed the shelf life of the product.

Certificates of Free Sale/Health Certificates should have the name and origin of the product, name of the producer or exporter, name and wet signature of the person who issued it, and one of the statements listed in Section II, paragraph six of this report. The original copy of the Certificate of Free Sale/Health Certificate is given to the provincial directorate of MinAF in the first consignment’s initial import control verification and is kept in the Food Safety Information System of MinAF. If the Certificate of Free Sale/Health Certificate does not contain information related to total or partial amount of the product, then the original copy can be applied to multiple listed consignments’ import controls until the validity of the Certificate of Free Sale/Health Certificate expires.

If the Certificate of Free Sale/Health Certificate is issued for a specific amount, it should contain the lot number and the quantity (weight, volume, or number of units) of the shipment in question and can also be used multiple times until the shipment reaches the amount mentioned in the Certificate.

For alcoholic beverages, certificates issued by the competent authority of the country where the product is bottled are also acceptable.

Phytosanitary Certificate:

For products which are subject to phytosanitary controls, a Certificate of Free Sale/Health Certificate is not required if the product is accompanied by a Phytosanitary Certificate.

The original Phytosanitary Certificate should accompany the products, and products may be rejected at the port if the original certificate does not accompany the products.

Please see the HS CODES of plant and plant products which require an accompanying Phytosanitary Certificate in APPENDIX-I-A of this report.

The following products do not need to be accompanied by a Phytosanitary Certificate:

- Fresh and dried fruits and vegetables not exceeding three kilograms for personal consumption,
- Non-commercial bouquet of flowers or garland, not more than one unit,
- Plant and plant products donated by foreign people to government agencies or charitable institutions (quarantine controls are carried out at customs and products are allowed after being cleared),
- Wooden packaging materials carrying goods and marked according to ISPM-15 rules.

Veterinary Health Certificate:

Unless indicated on the Veterinary Health Certificate:

- For animal products, the validity of the Veterinary Health Certificate is 15 days for products coming by air, 30 days for products coming by road, 60 days for products coming by rail, and 120 days for products coming by sea since the endorsement date,
- For breeding animals and animals other than breeding animals, the validity of the Veterinary Health Certificate is 15 days for animals coming by air and by road, 30 days for animals coming by rail, and 60 days for animals coming by sea since the endorsement date,
- For genetic materials, the validity of the Veterinary Health Certificate is 15 days for genetic materials coming by air (*the validity is 30 days for bovine semen coming from the United States), 30 days coming by road, 60 days for genetic materials coming by rail and 120 days for genetic materials coming by sea since the endorsement date.

*Since February 2018, bovine semen Veterinary Health Certificates do not have to be endorsed within two days prior to shipment from the United States. MinAF accepts the Veterinary Health Certificates for bovine semen from the United States ONLY to be endorsed within the validity period of the certificate, which is 30 days.

According to Turkish import regulations, Veterinary Health Certificates for animals and animal products to Turkiye must be signed by an official veterinarian in the exporting country two days prior to shipment. For dairy products, as an exception, MinAF accepts Veterinary Health Certificates endorsed by USDA Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS) inspectors.

Electronic Veterinary Health Certificates are not accepted by MinAF, and the original copy of the Veterinary Health Certificate must be provided when the animal or animal-origin product arrives at the customs or border inspection post.

Please see the HS codes of animal and animal sourced products which need to be accompanied by Veterinary Health Certificate in APPENDIX-II-A of this report.

Section IV: Other Certification/Accreditation Requirements to Ensure Market Entry

MinAF requires importers to obtain Control Certificates, which are considered pre-import permission and state whether the product is eligible for import, for animals, animal products, and certain plant products. Please see the HS codes of plant and plant products which require a Control Certificate before the import stage in APPENDIX I-B of this report.

For animals and animal sourced products which are subject to veterinary controls, please see the HS codes which require a Control Certificate before the import stage in APPENDIX II-B and the HS codes which do not require a Control Certificate before the import stage in APPENDIX-II-C of this report.

U.S. Radiation Monitoring

If the food/food ingredient in question is treated with ionizing radiation, MinAF requires an attestation from the facility which made the treatment. The treating facility must be in the European Union’s [List of approved facilities for the treatment of foods and food ingredients with ionizing radiation](#). The attestation must include the name and address of the treating facility and information related to the treatment process, like name and amount of the food/food ingredient treated with ionizing radiation, lot number, expiration date of the food/food ingredient, process tracking number given by the treating facility, name of the business operator who requested the treatment, name of the business operator importing the food/food ingredient, date of the treatment, information related to the packaging material used during the treatment, data related to controls of the treatment, and applied doses during the treatment. Post encourages exporters to contact their business partners in Turkiye about the exact content of this attestation before they export their commodities.
