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**Report Highlights:**

This report lists the major export certificates required by Burmese government agencies for U.S products exported to Burma. The list of certificates primarily focuses on major U.S exported products such as soybeans and soybean meal, wheat products, dried distillers grains with solubles, meat and poultry products, fruits and vegetables, other grocery items, and seeds. This report reflects updated certificate requirements for meat, poultry, animal feed, and human food exports to Burma.

## **SECTION II: PURPOSE OF SPECIFIC EXPORT CERTIFICATES**

The purpose of each specific export certificate is reflected in Section 1. For more information, please visit the following website: <https://myanmartradeportal.gov.mm/en>.

As noted in Section 1, Health Certificates are required for several product categories and must be signed by an authorized veterinary officer that certifies that the products are fit for human consumption. For food and feed additives that are produced from animals, a COA is required for quality assurance and to ensure the products meet the product specification and must be renewed every three months.

For processed foods, semi-processed foods, drinks, and beverages, a COA is required for each shipment (or per lot if multiple lots are in the shipment) for food safety requirements. Required testing varies by product category, but may include microbiological, chemical, and/or heavy metal testing and results must meet CODEX recommendations.

GMP, HACCP and ISO 22000 certification is required to ensure the imported foods are produced from the company whose production processes comply with good manufacturing practices.

## **SECTION III: SPECIFIC ATTESTATION REQUIRED ON CERTIFICATE**

The general attestation requirements are summarized in Section 1.

For beef and beef products, the animal must originate from foot and mouth disease-free zone. For Swine (frozen pork and pork product), the country of origin must be free from African Swine Fever, Enterovirus, Encephalomyelitis (Teschin Disease), Swine Vesicular Disease, and Rinderpest. For poultry and poultry products, the birds from which the product was derived cannot originate from a zone with highly pathogenic notifiable avian influenza. ## **SECTION IV: GOVERNMENT CERTIFICATE ENTRY REQUIREMENT**


The original certificates must accompany the products at the time of entry. Phytosanitary and sanitary certificates for plants, plant products, meat, or meat products cannot be used for multiple shipments. However, GMP and HACCP can be used for multiple shipments if they remain valid. The required frequency of COAs in different product categories is described in Section II. **Only Burmese citizens (importers) may submit product declarations.** Free sale certificates are not required for meat and poultry products, but are required for feed, drugs, and food products.

## **SECTION V: OTHER CERTIFICATION/ ACCREDITATION REQUIREMENTS TO ENSURE MARKET ENTRY**

If the product is re-exported through a third-country, an additional phytosanitary certificate (PC) will be required by that country. If a third-country mentions that the PC was issued for re-export, then the PC from the country of origin must also accompany the re-export phytosanitary certificate.

# APPENDIX 1: SCANNED COPIES OF CERTIFICATES
