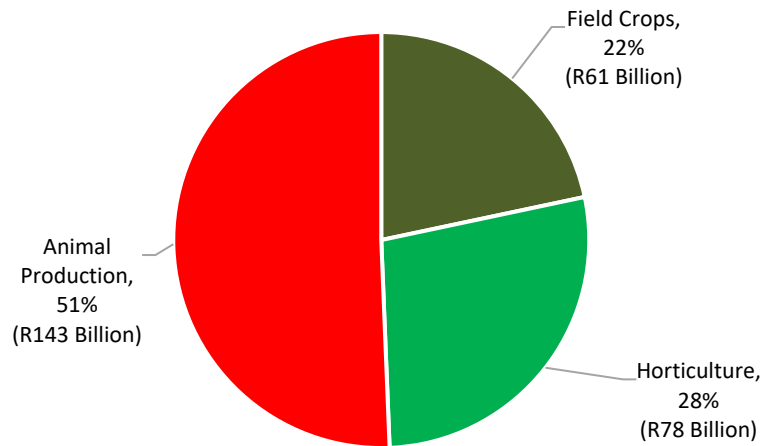
Report Highlights:

South Africa has a highly diversified agricultural sector which includes the production of all the major grains (except rice), oil seeds, deciduous and subtropical fruits, sugar, citrus, wine, most vegetables, cattle, dairy, pigs, sheep, broilers, ostriches and eggs. This fact sheet presents South Africa's agricultural production and exports by province, and the main ports used for agricultural exports.

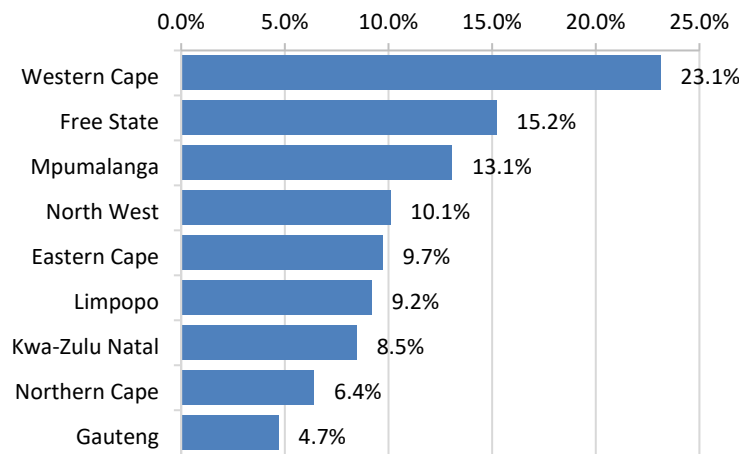

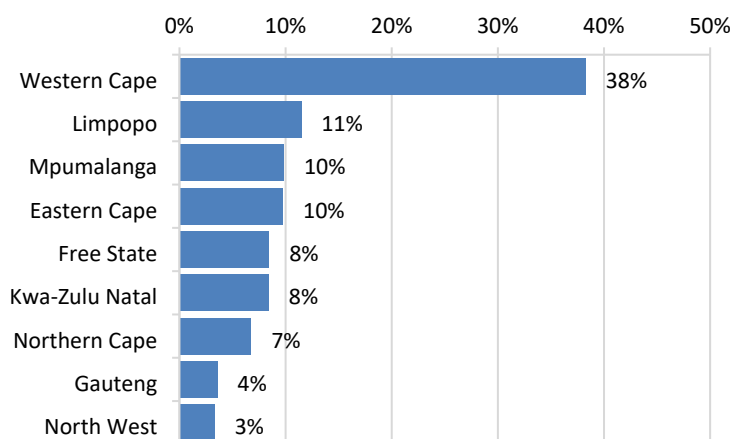

Name	Commodities
Cape Town, Western Cape	All agricultural and food products – Main commodities include all types of fruits, avocados, maize, wheat, barley, soya bean meal, rice and timber.
Durban, Kwa-Zulu Natal	All agricultural and food products – Main commodities include sugar, fruits (citrus), tree nuts, wheat, maize, soya bean meal, animal feed and woodchips.
Port Elizabeth, Eastern Cape	All agricultural and food products – Main commodities include maize, wheat, soya bean meal, timber, wool, textiles, skins and hides, citrus and deciduous fruit.
East London, Eastern Cape	All agricultural and food products – Main commodities include wheat, maize, fruits, sugar, and timber.
Mossel Bay, Western Cape	Fuel.
Richards Bay, Kwa-Zulu Natal	Woodchips.
