Report Highlights:

This report compliments the FAIRS Country Annual Report and provides information on certificates required by the Government of Tanzania (GoT) to export food and agricultural products into Tanzania. GoT provides Tanzania National Business Portal as a single point for exporters and importers to electronically submit and receive approvals from all the regulatory agencies that are involved in international trade.

Section II: Purpose of Specific Export Certificate

i. Certificate of Conformity (COC)

To assure Tanzanian consumers of the safety and quality of imported goods, and to protect Tanzanian manufacturers from unfair competition, the Tanzania Bureau of Standards (TBS), a statutory organization of the government of Tanzania, implemented guidelines called the Pre-Shipment Verification of Conformity (PVoC) to Standards Programme. Intertek Government and Trade services awarded a contract by TBS, commencing 1 September 2018, to provide certification services in support of its Pre-Shipment Verification of Conformity (PVoC) programme. The primary objective of applying Pre-Shipment Verification of Conformity (PVoC) Programme is:

- Ensure quality of products, health and safety
- Protect the environment for Tanzanians
- Meet requirements of the PVoC

All consignments subject to PVoC must obtain a Certificate of Conformity (CoC) issued by an authorized PVoC Agent, such as Intertek, prior to shipment. The CoC is a mandatory document for Customs Clearance in Tanzania; consignments arriving at Tanzanian Ports without this document will be denied entry into the country.

The key elements undertaken in the PVoC are:

- Physical inspection prior to shipment
- Sampling, testing and analysis in accredited laboratories
- Quality Audit of production processes
- Documentary review of conformity with regulations
- Issuance of Certificate of Conformity (CoC) or Non-Conformity Report (NCR) as appropriate.
- ii. Radioactivity Analysis Certificate

To assure Tanzania consumers that the food is free from radiation

iii. Phytosanitary certificate

A Phytosanitary approval is the procedure done by the Ministry of Agriculture (Department of Plant Health Services) to certify plant and plant products are free from regulated pests and conforms to other phytosanitary requirements of the exporting country.

In addition to the aforementioned certificates, the GoT requires the original proforma invoice from supplier of goods, bill of lading or airway bill, certificate of analysis of products (original) if buying from manufacture, food security permit, zoo-sanitary certificate (non-processed food of animal origin), blank certificate of origin (AGOA) depending with the country of origin, certificate of good manufacturing products (GMP) and insurance documents on U.S. exports to Tanzania, please visit Tanzania National Business Portal.
