Report Highlights:

On September 7, Taiwan awarded its 4th public rice tender for 2004. The tender for 20,000 tons of medium brown rice went to a U.S. rice supplier at NT\$11,596/mt or \$341.76/mt. The last tender of 2004 for 20,068 tons will be announced by the end of September. (Current exchange rate is \$1 = NT\$39.93.)

Fourth Public Rice Tender Completed

On September 7, Taiwan awarded its fourth public rice tender of 2004 (see below). Three bidders, all representing U.S. supplier, competed for the two tenders of 10,000 metric tons each. The tenders for public import rice have gone smoothly so far in 2004. The ceiling prices set by the Council of Agriculture (COA) for 2004 tenders, have not interfered with the tendering process.

- 1. Tender No.: GF4-930200 of 10,000 mt of Medium Grain Brown Rice was awarded to a U.S. supplier at price NT\$11,596/mt or \$341.76/mt.
- 2. Tender No.: GF4-930201 of 10,000 mt of Medium Grain Brown Rice was awarded to a U.S. supplier at price NT\$11,596/mt or \$341.76/mt.

(Note: Both tenders were awarded to the same U.S. supplier at the same price.)

As of September 7, Taiwan has tendered for 74,000 tons of rice on a brown basis, accounting for 79 percent of the 94,068-ton public trade rice quota. The United States has supplied 58,850 tons of medium grain, while Australia has been awarded 10,000 tons of medium-short grain. Thailand has supplied 1,700 tons of long grain plus 3,450 tons of long grain glutinous rice.

The next tender for 20,068 tons is scheduled for by the end of September.
