Report Highlights: 1998 production of apples and pears is strong (2.14 and 1.07 mmt respectively). Apple exports in 1997/98 increased to 515,000 mt but at a reduced value due to sales of low cost apples to Russia and Eastern Europe.

## **Executive Summary**

Updated figures for Italian fresh deciduous fruit production in 1998 confirm a significant increase in apple and pear production from 1997 due to favorable weather conditions. However, output levels are slightly different than reported in the September annual report (IT8038).

Italian table grape output, however, is revised downward slightly, to almost the same levels of 1997.

Final data for 1997/98 Italian fruit exports show a significant increase of Italian apple exports compared to 1997. However, the apple exports were lower in value than the previous year as a result of large sales of low priced apples to Russia and other Eastern European countries. The exports were partially balanced by increased imports. After the drop in 1997/98, Italian pear exports are expected to recover in 1998/99 due to increased output.

Italian apple planted area is forecast to decline approximately 18 percent in North Italy by 2001. For pear planted area the forecast decline is minimal (about 4 percent). The decline is due to uprooting of fruit crops in marginal production areas due to increased international competition.

An agreement on zero duties for fruit imports is under discussion between the European Union and South Africa. The latest official reports are that this agreement would allow 65,000 tons of apples and pears, together with many other fruits and fruit products such as canned deciduous fruit, would be allowed to enter the European Union without duty. However, recent reports from the industry are that fresh fruit has been removed from the proposal and that the agreement would allow 60,000 tons of canned fruit to enter the European Union at a 50% import duty reduction.
