Report Highlights:

Korean imports of GSM-102 eligible commodities totaled \$5.2 billion in CY 1999, and a 13-percent increase over the CY 1998 total. Meats, horticultural and wood products accounted for the \$903 million increase in CY 1999 trade. Total imports of grain declined on a value basis due to a lower per unit value. On a market share basis, the U.S. position fell in CY 1999 to 44 percent, down from the CY 1998 position of 49 percent.
