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
Report Highlights:

Morocco is facing historically low wheat production due to low rainfall in 2019/20. The Ministry of Agriculture forecasts total wheat and barley production at 3 million metric tons, about 60 percent below Morocco's ten-year production average. In response to low production, the Moroccan government has taken the unprecedented decision to extend its suspension of customs duties on common wheat through December 31, 2020.

Crop Update:

Morocco finished the 2019/20 wheat and barley crop year under poor conditions. Since the end of February 2020, Morocco has experienced insufficient rainfall. Faced with a below-average vegetation index (mid-Feb through Jun), Morocco began an early harvest near the end of May.

On April 24, 2020, the Ministry of Agriculture released its first production forecast for wheat and barley production. The Ministry of Agriculture estimated the total harvest at 3 MMT, including 1.65 MMT of common wheat, 0.75 MMT of durum wheat, and 0.6 MMT of barley. Wheat production has fallen 60 percent below Morocco's ten-year average. Post adjusts its production estimates for wheat and barley to reflect Ministry of Agriculture estimates.

Policy Update:

On May 7, 2020, the Government of Morocco extended its suspension of customs duties on common wheat through December 31, 2020. The decision to lift wheat import duties through the summer months is unprecedented. Historically, Morocco raises tariffs during the summer harvest period in order to protect local wheat producers (See <u>GAIN report</u>).

On May 15, 2020, the Minister of Agriculture and the Minister of Economy and Finance signed a joint decision regarding the implementation of a number of measures to help farmers market their harvest for the 2019-2020 crop year, effective June 1-July 31,2020. The measures include:

• The reference price for common wheat is maintained at 2,800 Dh/MT (≈\$280/MT).

- Providing a biweekly storage premium of 20 Dh/MT (≈\$2/MT) for grain traders and Moroccan agricultural cooperatives to store their wheat at facilities licensed by ONICL.
- A subsidy for millers and common wheat buyers at the rate of 50 Dh/MT (≈\$5/MT) For more information, see Circular #03/ONICL, 2020.
- Morocco's grain sector continues to weather the COVID-19 crisis, remaining open and operational throughout the nation's state of emergency. Agribusiness leader's report that mills are operating at full capacity, that wheat imports continue, and that ports are operational. Moroccan officials are well prepared to manage a record low wheat harvest.
