Report Highlights:

The Government of Morocco has released its official numbers for wheat and barley production for the 2019 crop, including 2.7 MMT of common wheat, 1.3 MMT of durum wheat, and 1.2 MMT of barley. On September 19, 2019, Morocco's state cereals office (ONICL) issued tenders for U.S. common and durum wheat with auction results to be announced in October 1-2, 2019. U.S. wheat deliveries must arrive no later than December 31, 2019.

General Information:

Production Update

On August 8, 2019, the Government of Morocco announced that 2019 wheat and barley production reached 5.2MMT (2.7 MMT of common wheat, 1.3 MMT of durum wheat, and 1.2 MMT of barley). Post adjusts its MY2019/20 production numbers for wheat and barley to reflect Morocco's revised official numbers.

Policy Update

On September 19, 2019, Morocco's state cereals office (ONICL) issued tenders for U.S. and EU common and durum wheat with auction results to be announced on October 1-2, 2019. U.S. wheat deliveries must arrive no later than December 31, 2019. This follows a tender issued on August 19, 2019, which received no bids. (See August tender results). Wheat industry contacts report that they declined to bid on the August tender as they anticipated that the Government of Morocco would lower its tariff on wheat. As expected, the common wheat tariff was lowered from 135 to 30 percent, resulting in the September tender. Exporters have expressed confidence that they will be able to fill quota under this tariff with expected deliveries taking place up to December 31. Post notes that the United States benefits from a preferential in-quota duty under the U.S.-Morocco Free Trade Agreement. At the current rate of 30 percent, the preferential rate for U.S. common wheat is 9.9 percent. Durum wheat is subject to a 2.5 percent tariff, with a U.S. preferential rate of zero. The EU receives the same preferential tariff rates.
