Report Highlights:

This report contains the marketing year (MY) 2020/21 harvest data for wheat, barley, and corn in Croatia.

General Information

Croatia's current growing season benefited from favorable weather and moisture conditions for most grains. For the third consecutive year corn yield was exceptionally good, which will result in high exports. Increases in exports of wheat and barley are also expected due to the favorable weather.

Wheat

Preliminary yield data for MY 2020/21 is 809,000 MT from 142,000 ha planted. Exports are expected at a high of 552,000 MT. However, wheat quality is mainly medium to low. Thus, imports of quality wheat and durum wheat for flour blending is expected at over 120,000 MT, which is similar to previous years.

Barley

Preliminary yield data for MY 2020/21 is 296,000 MT from 58,000 ha planted. Exports are expected at 60,000 MT and imports are expected at 11,000 MT

Corn

Preliminary yield data for MY 2020/21 is 2,32 million MT from 258,000 ha planted. Exports are expected at a high of 900,000 MT and imports are expected to be negligible. Exports will be in accordance with corn availability on the domestic market and current low demand for feed, which has been the trend over the last few years due to the decreasing number of bovine animals.
