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**Report Highlights:**

This report contains Post's production estimates for marketing year (MY) 2022/23, as well as final export numbers for MY2021/22. Production is down sharply as a result of Russia's invasion of Ukraine and the impact on agriculture. Domestic consumption for all grains (both feed and food) went down as a combination of migration out of the country, decreased disposable incomes, and destroyed animal production facilities in the areas of military activity. The combination of decreased consumption and exports lead to the accumulation of large ending stocks both for MY2021/22 and MY2022/23.

## Production

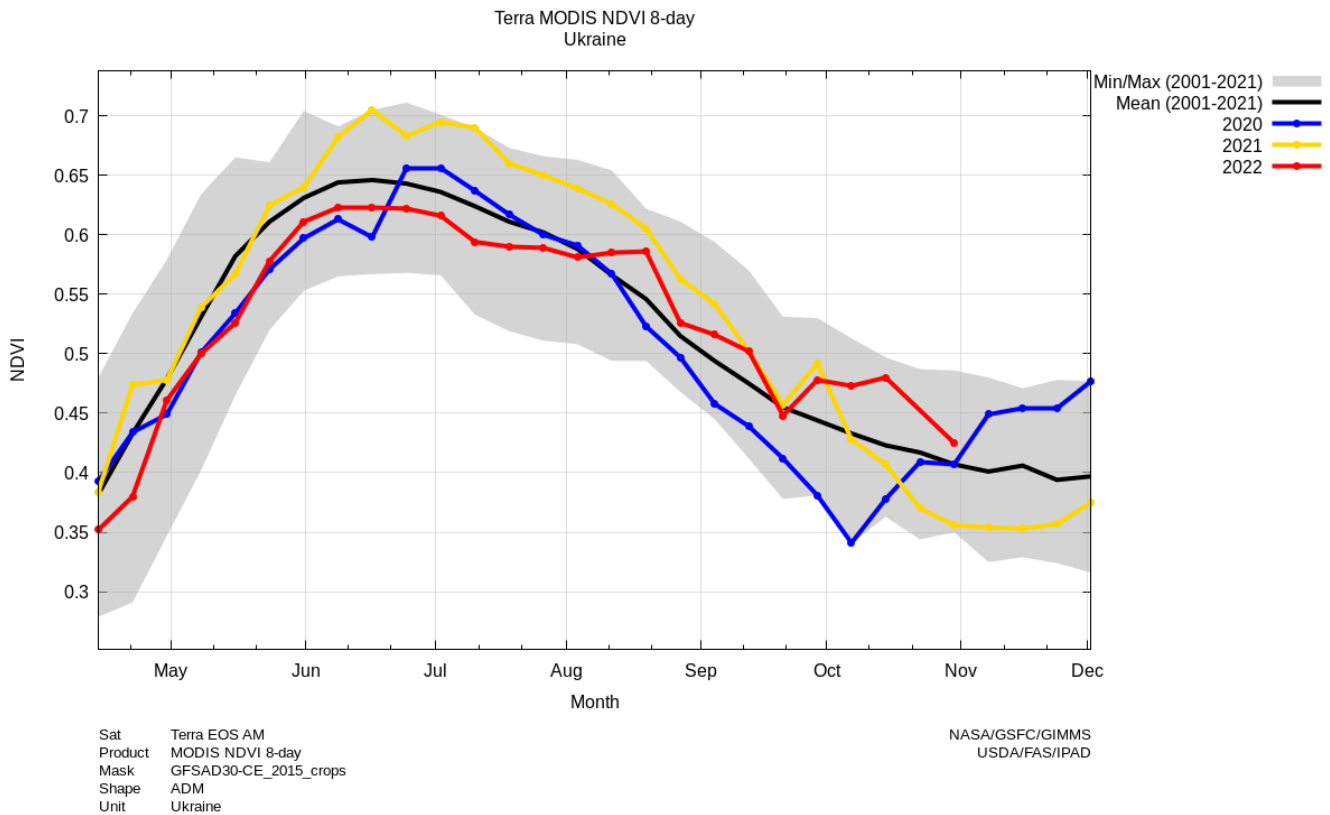
At the time of this report, harvesting has been completed for wheat, barley, and rye. FAS Kyiv estimates the following production numbers for MY2022/23: barley – 5.9 MMT, corn – 21.2 MMT, wheat – 19.6 MMT, and rye – 336,000 MT.

*Post note: the abovementioned numbers are in the final weight and include Crimea.*

Large corn areas will not be harvested during the normal time frame (before December 2022), and MY2022/23 harvesting progress is significantly delayed compared to the previous MY. As of November 7, only 27 percent of the estimated corn crop area has been harvested, compared to 61 percent harvested for the same date the previous year.

At this stage, Post estimates that around 10 percent of planted corn areas might not be harvested as farmers are facing both shortages of funds for fuel and available storage. An additional factor impacting a farmer's decision to harvest is a ratio between the farm-gate price, which is tied to functional logistics for grains, and the price of natural gas routinely used to dry up grains. Under some circumstances, it makes no economic sense for a farmer to harvest grains when a farm-gate price goes below a certain threshold. The reduced harvested area has been reflected in the relevant PSD table.

Based on NDVI patterns (see the relevant graph below), the MY2022/23 corn yield is estimated higher than for MY2020/21, but below the record-breaking MY2021/22.



Based on the abovementioned area and yield numbers, MY2022/23 corn production is estimated at 25.8 MMT.

## Consumption

Total grain food consumption declined by over 12 percent during MY2021/22 compared to the prior year. It is forecast to continue to decline in MY2022/23. These estimates take into account lower population, predominantly based on the number of refugees [reported by UNHCR](#), that have left the country since the beginning of the armed conflict with Russia started in late February 2022.

Feed consumption is estimated to have declined in MY2021/22 with less animal production. Notably, MY2021/22 Feed and Residual estimates also include grains destroyed due to active military conflict, in addition to normal feed consumption. MY2022/23 Feed and Residual is estimated based on the assumption of less damage to grain supplies in the coming year. The armed conflict is localized in Southern and Eastern Ukraine at the time of the report writing, whereas corn is predominantly grown in the Central and Western areas.

## Exports

MY2021/22 exports have concluded at the time of the report writing. Post's export estimates are as follows:

- barley – 5.7 MMT (July 2021 – June 2022);
- corn – 27.3 MMT (October 2021 – September 2022);
- wheat – 18.8 MMT (July 2021 – June 2022);
- rye – 162,000 MT (July 2021 – June 2022).

It should be noted that the armed conflict with Russia led to crippled grain logistics for the second half of MY2021/22. Ukraine lost access to its ports on the Sea of Azov because of the Russian occupation, and its Black Sea ports were inoperable from the end of February until early August 2022.

Before the [Black Sea Grain Initiative](#) (BSGI), which was signed on July 27, 2022, Ukraine was relying solely on a rail, truck, and barge logistics to get agricultural products out of the country. The BSGI opened the way for maritime exports from three key Black Sea ports: Odesa, Chornomorsk, and Pivdennyi (Southern). This allowed 4.7 MMT of grains exports (corn, wheat, barley) in September 2022, compared to 1.7 MMT in July 2022.

Post's MY2022/23 export estimates are based on the scenario that the BSGI will not be extended past the original 120-day duration in November. Under this assumption, maritime exports will cease to exist by the end of November 2022. Inland export capacity is estimated by Post at 2.5 MMT per month for all grains and oilseeds, with a gradual increase up to 3 MMT in 2023. Post assumes that Ukraine will predominantly export wheat and corn with smaller quantities of barley.

Under these assumptions, MY2022/23 Post's export estimates are as follows:

- barley – 2.7 MMT;
- corn – 13.9 MMT;

- wheat – 12.4 MMT;
- rye – 80,000 MT.

## Ending Stocks

Ukraine started amassing grain stocks for MY2021/22 because of issues with exports. Post expects continued accumulation of grain stocks for MY2022/23 under the baseline scenario of constrained exports discussed above, although the decreased production numbers will alleviate the situation a bit.
