Promising future for Chilean Hazelnut Growers


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Report Highlights:

A planting rate of growth of over 1,000 hectares a year, close to 3,000 MT exported last year and a reported continuous fall in production in Turkey, the largest world producer, are the main factors that are making hazelnut planting, production and exports booming.



General Information:

Ten years ago Chile had less than one thousand hectares planted with hazelnut trees. Today there are already more than 13,000 hectares planted by an estimated 200 farmers/producers between Region VII (Talca) and Region IX (Temuco). With the high current planting rate and the potential for increased production, industry sources have indicated that Chile could easily become the third largest producer of hazelnuts in year 2020. By then, over 20,000 hectares are expected to be planted with a yearly production of over 25 thousand Metric Tons.

The Chilean Hazelnut harvest starts in early April in Region IX (Temuco) and peaks during March in Region VII (Talca). This year, due to excellent weather conditions, analysts predict a rather large increase in production. An increase of 10 to 20 percent of the price for hazelnuts are expected due to favorable market conditions, as was indicated by industry sources.

Industry sources have indicated that Turkey, the world largest hazelnut producer with an estimated yearly production of 560,000 MT is likely to reduce production of as much as 30 percent during the next 10 years. This is most likely because if Turkey joins the European Union, Turkey will have to reduce subsidies in the agricultural sector. As a result the Turkish government already has announced changes in policies that support hazelnut production.
