Report Highlights:

During the first half of CY 1999, Korean imports of GSM-102 eligible commodities totaled \$2.5 billion, a 4-percent increase from a year earlier. Imports from U.S. reached \$1.1 billion, down from \$1.2 billion in the same period last year. Total U.S. market share declined to 44% from 49% in CY 1999. The large gains in corn imports from U.S. was not enough to cover up the free-fall in cotton imports from U.S. and the loss in soymeal imports from U.S.
