## **Report Highlights:**

During the first nine months of CY 1999, Korean imports of GSM-102 eligible commodities totaled \$3.8 billion, a 9-percent increase from a year earlier. Low per unit value for grains and soybeans continue to obfuscate the increase in import volume. U.S. market share is increasing for meat and corn increased, but decreasing for soybeans and cotton products.
