Report Highlights:

Japan's trade data for January -October 1999 shows a 4.8 percent increase in soybean imports from the United States compared to the same period last year. Imports from all sources were up by 3.7 percent to reach 4 million metric tons. There was a notable increase in Canadian soybean imports which rose 60.3 percent. Also up were imports from Brazil which rose 16.1 percent to reach 531,757 metric tons.

According to Ministry of Finance trade data for January-October 1999, U.S. soybean imports were up 4.8 percent

compared to the same period last year amounting to 3.2 million metric tons. Imports from all sources were up by 3.7 percent compared to the same period last year to reach 4 million metric tons. There was a notable increase in Canadian soybean imports which rose 60.3 percent to reach 127,283 metric tons. Also up were imports from Brazil which rose 16.1 percent to reach 531,757 metric tons.

It is estimated that of Japan's total annual soybean imports (about 5 million metric tons), food soybean imports amount to one million metric tons (please note, there is no separate HS code or trade category for food-use soybeans, so estimates are based on industry information). The United States maintains a 80 percent market share in food-use soybean imports. However, as a result of the Government of Japan's announcement (August 1999) to introduce mandatory labeling for certain GMO products beginning 2001, many Japanese trading companies, food manufactures and supermarkets have announced plans to shift to non-GMO foods and food ingredients. Details of the January-October 1999 soybean trade are shown in the following table.
