Report Highlights:

Japan's National Tax Agency (NTA) proposed 9 new geographical indications (GIs) for alcoholic beverages from the United Kingdom. NTA will accept public comments on the proposal through January 16, 2023.

General Information

After the Japan-European Union (EU) Economic Partnership Agreement (EPA) went into effect on February 1, 2019, Japan's National Tax Agency (NTA) recognized geographical indication (GI) protections for 139 EU-produced alcoholic beverages (see <u>JA8003</u>), including Scotch Whisky. Following the United Kingdom's (UK) exit from the EU, UK and Japan concluded the <u>UK-Japan Comprehensive EPA</u> (see <u>JA2021-0005</u>), and <u>NTA</u> recognized GIs for Scotch Whisky, UK-produced Irish Cream and UK-produced Irish Whisky. On December 22, 2021, the NTA proposed <u>10 additional GIs for UK alcoholic beverages</u> (JA2021-0164).

On December 16, 2022, the NTA published a <u>list of 9 more GIs</u> for alcoholic beverages from the UK: 2 types of wine, and 7 other categories of alcoholic beverages, such as cider.
