Report Highlights: On March 9, 2000 the Ministry of Finance and Economy revised the CY 2000 minimum market access (MMA) quota amounts for 22 commodities. The announcement noted MMA quota revisions were necessary to reduce an imbalance in the commodity supply and demand situation or to supply raw materials for production of products which would generate foreign currency for the country. This revision is effective as of March 9 and will remain in place through the remainder of CY 2000.
