Report Highlights:

This report presents China Customs recorded January 2005 agricultural, fishery, and forestry commodity trade. January agricultural, fish, and forestry imports were \$2.7 billion of which, \$690 million originated from the United States. Imports consist primarily of soybeans, cotton, wheat, palm and soybean oils, and in-the-rough wood. China's agricultural, fishery, and forestry exports equaled \$2.6 billion, primarily processed aquatic and wooden products.

Executive Summary

The Agricultural Affairs Office at the U.S. Embassy in Beijing provides this report for information purposes only; no analysis has been provided. Readers should be aware that China Customs data in this report will not match other countries' export statistics due to the timing of exports (e.g., trade recorded in an exporting country in one month may not show up in China's data until the following month). Furthermore, values from one country to another may vary due to disparity in recording methods (e.g., FOB vs. CIF/landed price). Also, inconsistencies may exist as a result of Hong Kong or Macau re-export trade to or from China. Finally, some inconsistencies may result from the re-classification of goods between countries Customs officials (e.g., hard wheat from one country may be classified as Durum by China).

USDA GAIN report CH5013 contains data and analysis for calendar year 2002, 2003, and 2004.
