### **Report Highlights:**

On December 27, the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Affairs (MARA) announced the issuance of new and renewed biosafety certificates for genetically engineered (GE) events. The announcement includes 34 certificates issued for biotech crops approved for import as processing materials and 19 renewed certificates for domestic cultivation and production. The validity period of the new biosafety certificates is five years.

#### **Summary:**

On December 27, MARA announced the issuance of new and renewed biosafety certificates for GE events. The announcement includes 34 certificates issued for biotech crops approved for import as processing materials (including two new GE cotton events and the renewal of 32 other events) and 19 renewed certificates for domestic cultivation and production (including 16 GE cotton events, two animal vaccines, and one feed additive enzyme). The validity period of the new biosafety certificates is five years (December 17, 2021 – December 16, 2026). The two lists (in Chinese) are available on the MARA webpage for agricultural biotechnology. The end-of-year announcement represents the only new and renewed biosafety certificates issued for GE crops for import as processing materials in 2021 though there was a January 2021 announcement for certificates issued in December 2020.
