Oilseeds Update - November 2000

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Report Highlights:

Estimates of this year's peanut and soybean crops have been reduced to 5.9 and 5.25 million tons, respectively, due to poor growing conditions in major producing areas. Oil imports for MY 1999 (Oct-Sep) were a record 4.5 million tons.

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MY 2000 Peanut, Soybean Estimates Lowered

Despite a marginal increase in planted area, Post's estimate of MY 2000 peanut production has been reduced by 200,000 tons to 5.9 million due to dry conditions in the major producing region of Gujarat and a viral attack, coupled with flooding, in Andhra Pradesh (the second largest peanut growing state). Production in Karnataka and Tamil Nadu, however, is benefitting from better conditions with higher yields expected.

Post's estimate of MY 2000 soybean production has been reduced to 5.25 million tons (despite larger acreage) due to poor growing conditions in southern Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan. The quality of the crop, however, is better than last year's. Depressed oil and meal prices pressured bean prices at the start of the marketing season to \$174 - \$183/ton, well under the government's support level (\$188/ton). Prices are expected to drop further as arrivals peak.

Edible Oil Imports Continue to Surge

Post's estimate of MY 1999 edible oil imports remains unchanged at 4.5 million tons. In response to policy changes introduced in January 2000, imports of crude oil accounted for 47 percent of total imports compared with 32 percent last year. Imports of crude palm oil were especially strong, encouraged by the differential duty and the capability of the hydrogenated vegetable oil manufacturers to process it into "vanaspati".

In an effort to prevent kharif oilseed prices from falling below support levels, members of the national body of solvent extractors have called on the government to raise the basic duty on refined soyoil to the WTO bound level of 45 percent (thereby raising the effective applied tariff to 51 percent), and increase the duty on other refined oils to 75 percent (raising the effective applied tariff to 82 percent). Several sectors of government support this proposal.

Oil Meal Exports Decline:

MY 1999 meal exports are estimated at 2.3 million tons, down 21 per cent from last year. The decline is mainly attributed to reduced exports of soybean meal, stemming from lower world prices, increased domestic demand and a smaller domestic soybean crop. Exports of rapeseed and peanut meal have declined drastically due to the availability of cheaper soybean meal. Most buyers of Indian rapeseed meal have turned toward better quality Chinese rape meal or protein rich soymeal.
