Report Highlights:

On August 24, the General Administration of Customs of China (GACC) suspended all imports of aquatic products (including edible aquatic animals) from Japan, effective immediately. The announcement follows Japan's announced plans to begin releasing more than one million metric tons of treated radioactive water from the Fukushima power plant into the Pacific Ocean. This report provides an unofficial translation of the GACC announcement and initial review of impacted trade.

On August 24, GACC issued <u>Announcement No. 103 of 2023 (Announcement on Suspension of Import of Japanese Aquatic Products)</u>, suspending all imports of aquatic products (including edible aquatic animals) from Japan.

Japan is a major supplier of seafood products to China, with 2022 imports of 155,429 MT valued at \$546 million. China's imports of seafood from Japan have grown in recent years, up 31 percent by volume compared to 2019. By volume, mollusks (HS Code 0307) and frozen fish (HS Code 0303) account for 67 percent and 28 percent, respectively, in 2022. In 2022, China's seafood imports from the United States were 280,029 MT, of which frozen fish (HS Code 0303) was 214,356 MT or 76 percent, followed by mollusks at 16 percent (HS Code 0307) and fish fillet (HS Code 0304) at 4.6 percent.

Announcement No. 103 of 2023

In order to comprehensively prevent the risk of radioactive pollution caused by Japan's Fukushima nuclear pollution water discharge to food safety, protect the health of Chinese consumers, and ensure the safety of imported food, in accordance with the "Food Safety Law of the People's Republic of China" and its implementation regulations, "The Import and Export of the People's Republic of China" According to the relevant provisions of the Measures for the Administration of Export Food Safety and the relevant provisions of the Agreement on the Implementation of Sanitary and Phytosanitary Measures of the World Trade Organization, the General Administration of Customs has decided to completely suspend the import of aquatic products originating in Japan from August 24, 2023 (inclusive) (including edible aquatic animals).
