Report Name: Pakistan's Corn Exports at Record Level

Country: Pakistan

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Report Highlights:

Corn exports in 2023/24 are forecast to reach 1.5 million tons. The good harvest and decrease in poultry feed demand resulted in a large exportable surplus at competitive prices. Vietnam, Malaysia, and Sri Lanka are the top destinations. Feed consumption in 2023/24 is reduced from 7.7 to 6.6 million tons.

Corn Exports at Record Pace

Corn exports in marketing year (July/June) 2023/24 are projected at a record 1.5 million tons. The bumper harvest and decrease in demand for corn from the poultry industry led to a significant exportable surplus at competitive global prices. From July through December 2023, corn exports totaled 1.1 million tons. Vietnam is the top importer, followed by Malaysia and Sri Lanka (Tables 1 and 2).

Driven by the demand from the poultry sector, corn production has grown steadily in recent years. In 2023, rising input costs and the ban on GE soybean imports adversely impacted the poultry sector, reducing domestic feed demand. Consequently, 2023/24 feed and residual consumption is reduced from 7.7 to 6.6 million tons.

The devaluation of the Pakistani rupee also helped exporters offer competitive prices in the world market. However, reportedly the pace of exports has recently slowed because most of stocks from the spring crop with low moisture content have already been exported and remaining stocks are of inferior quality.
