**Report Highlights:**

The Russian Government published Resolution #663, which amends resolutions of 2003 and 2004 regarding poultry import quotas. The poultry quota volume for 2005 was increased from 1.05 million metric tons (MMT) to 1.09 MMT. The US allocation was increased from 771,900 MT to 811,900 MT. Other countries' allocations were not specified.

On November 12, 2005, the Russian Government published Resolution #663, which amends Resolution #48 dated January 23, 2003 and #880 dated December 30, 2004. According to the new resolution, the poultry quota volume is 1.09 million metric tons (MMT), of which the United States is allocated 811,900 MT. The previously approved poultry import quota was 1,050,000 tons, including 771,900 MT for the United States. Allocations for other countries were not specified in the new resolution.

1. Annex #1 to Russian Federation Government Resolution #48 dated January 23, 2003 "On Measures to Protect Russian Poultry Production" (Collection of Russian Federation Government Legislation, 2003, #5, art. 487; #49, art. 4777; 2005, #1, art. 124) should be formulated as follows:

2. In Russian Federation Government Resolution of December 30, 2004, #880 "On Particulars of Applying the Special Protective Measure in Respect to Poultry Meat in 2005" (Collection of Russian Federation Legislation, 2005, #1, art. 124):
- a) in clause 1, the words "in the amount of 1,050,000 tons" must be replaced with the words "in the amount of 1,090,000 tons;"
  - b) in the annex to the stated resolution, the position relating to the USA must be formulated as follows: "USA 811.9."
