## Result of 5<sup>th</sup> SBS Tender for Feed Wheat and Barley 2002

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> Report Highlights: On November 21, the Food Agency (FA) conducted its fifth Simultaneous Buy and Sell (SBS) tender for feed wheat and barley during Japanese fiscal year 2002. The FA contracted 3,025 metric tons (MT) of wheat and 180,000 MT of barley. According to trade sources, all of the wheat will be purchased from China and at least 56,000 MT of barley will be purchased from either Ukraine or Germany.

On November 21, the Food Agency (FA) of the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (MAFF) conducted its fifth simultaneous buy and sell (SBS) tender for feed wheat and barley during Japanese fiscal year 2002 (April 2002 - March 2003).

The FA contracted 3,025 metric tons (MT) of wheat for feed and 180,000 MT of barley for feed. Information on country allocations is not available because country of origin is not required on the bids. However, according to industry sources, all of the wheat was contracted with China and at least 56,000 MT of barley will be purchased from either the Ukraine or Germany (importers may designate multiple 2 purchase points). Reports indicate that the importers would have returned to North American grain except for 1) the current tight supply and high prices for grain from traditional suppliers and 2) uncertainty over timely deliveries due to a potential resumption of the U.S. West Coast port lockout in late December which would affect January shipments. Considering that Japanese feed manufacturers seem to have been satisfied with the quality of the Ukrainian wheat and barley delivered to date, the buyers decided to continue purchasing from Europe. The wheat purchases from China in this tender are considered to be a test(as was done earlier this year for Ukranian grain) to evaluate its quality versus its low price.
