Rice export prices remain unchanged at high levels. Exporters continued to secure white and parboiled rice for contracted bulk shipments to African countries. In addition, most contracted container shipments are still facing delays due to a lack of available containers. The Thai baht remains still strong at around 29.9 baht/U.S. \$1.00, which is well above the exchange rate of 30-32 baht/U.S. \$1.00 in 2020.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for January 11-17, 2021, totaled 48,656 metric tons, down 19,816 metric tons from the previous week and down 2,088 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 50,744 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1-17, 2021, totaled 117,267 metric tons, down 23 percent from the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013 and December 18, 2016, export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FAS/BKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
