Export prices of white rice increased 1 percent as the Thai baht strengthened to 32.85 baht/\$1.00 from the previous week's exchange rate of 33.12 baht/\$1.00. In addition, exporters continued sourcing white rice to fulfil contracted shipments that the container shortage had delayed. Export prices of parboiled rice declined 1 percent due to a lack of new inquiries. Most contracted parboiled rice shipments, particularly to African countries, were bulk shipments.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for January 24-30, 2022, totaled 157,661 metric tons, up 14,354 metric tons from the previous week and up 26,596 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 131,065 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1-30, 2022, totaled 524,259 metric tons, up 74 percent from the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013, and December 18, 2016, export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FAS/BKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
