Export prices for all grades of rice dropped 1-3 percent from the previous week as domestic consumption slowed due to a new COIVD-19 outbreak in Thailand.

Export prices for all grades of rice dropped 1-3 percent from the previous week as domestic consumption slowed due to a new COVID-19 outbreak in Thailand. More than half of MY2020/21 off-season rice acreage has been harvested, with 40 percent, around 2.25 million rai (360,945 hectare) left to be harvested. MY2021/22 main crop rice planting has started in the northern region, despite declining domestic rice prices and higher costs for inputs such as chemical fertilizer. The Thai baht also weakened to 31.31 baht/U.S. \$1.00 from the previous week's exchange rate of 31.08 baht/U.S. \$1.00.

## **Rice Export Update**

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for April 19-25, 2021, totaled 30,530 metric tons, up 21,535 metric tons from the previous week and up 159 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 30,371 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 – April 25, 2021, totaled 882,792 metric tons, down 34 percent from the same period last year.



**Note on data:** Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013 and December 18, 2016, export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FAS/BKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
