Report Highlights:

Export prices of white and parboiled rice decreased slightly despite the appreciation of the Thai baht against the U.S. dollar due to a lack of new inquiries.

Export prices of white and parboiled rice decreased slightly despite the continued appreciation of the Thai baht to 30.95 baht/U.S. \$1.00 compared to the previous week's exchange rate of 31.02 baht/U.S. \$1.00. Trading activities remain quiet due to high freight costs and continued container shortages.

Around 40 percent of MY2021/22 main-crop rice has been planted, particularly in the lower northern region and the central plains, totaling approximately 6.6 million rai (1.1 million hectare). Rice fields in the lower northern plain are still experiencing low rain; however, rice fields in the northern and the north eastern regions will benefit from the tropical depression "KOGUMA" this week.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for June 7-13, 2021, totaled 44,517 metric tons, down 6,383 metric tons from the previous week and down 11,289 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 55,806 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1-13, 2021, totaled 1,403,383 metric tons, down 25 percent from the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013 and December 18, 2016, export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FAS/BKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
