Report Highlights:

Rice export prices declined 3-5 percent due to a lack of new inquiries.

Despite concerns about the current strength of the Thai baht, which is at around 30.7 baht/U.S. \$1.00, rice export prices declined 3-5 percent from the previous week due to a lack of new inquiries. Foreign buyers are reportedly seeking Vietnamese rice, which is U.S. \$40-50/MT cheaper as new-crop rice supplies enter the market. Additionally, most of Thai rice exporters have fulfilled their outstanding contracted shipments settled in May 2020 when Thai and Vietnamese rice prices converged.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for June 15-21, 2020, totaled 97,450 metric tons, up 15,936 metric tons from the previous week and up 26,700 metric tons from the four weeks moving average of 70,750 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 – June 21, 2020, totaled 2,021,562 metric tons, down 38 percent from the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, during May 1, 2013 - December 18, 2016, export data did not include 25% - 100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FAS/BKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
