Report Highlights:

Export prices remain unchanged at high levels as the Thai baht is still strong.

Export prices remain unchanged at high levels as the Thai baht is still strong at around 31 baht/U.S. \$1.00 compared to the previous week's exchange rate of 30.95 baht/U.S. \$1.00. Trading is reportedly inactive due to a lack of new inquiries as foreign buyers secured rice supplies from other suppliers. Vietnamese rice export prices continued to increase to unusual high levels that were roughly U.S. \$15/MT above Thai white rice prices, compared to typical Vietnamese export prices that are usually U.S. \$20-30/MT lower than Thai rice prices.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for July 27 – August 2, 2020, totaled 37,727 metric tons, down 28,954 metric tons from the previous week and down 19,706 metric tons from the four weeks moving average of 57,433 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 – August 2, 2020, totaled 2,367,826 metric tons, down 38 percent from the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, during May 1, 2013 - December 18, 2016, export data did not include 25% - 100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FAS/BKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
