## **Report Highlights:**

Export prices of all grades of rice remained unchanged despite a further weakening of the Thai baht against the U.S. dollar.

Export prices of all grades of rice remained unchanged from the previous week despite the weakening of the Thai baht to 33.25 baht/U.S. \$1.00 from the previous week's exchange rate of 32.73 baht/U.S. \$1.00. Traders are reportedly seeking Thai rice for shipments to African and Asian countries. Iraq agreed to purchase an additional 44,000 metric tons of Thai white rice after the purchase of 44,000 metric tons in August 2021. The shipment will take place in mid-October. Thai rice exporters are optimistic about rice exports for the rest of 2021 due to favorable exchange rates and the downward pressure on Thai rice prices.

The Ministry of Agriculture and Cooperatives reported that heavy rain from monsoon thunderstorms have adversely affected around 108,821 rai (17,411 hectare) of MY2021/22 main-crop rice, particularly in the central plains and the lower northern region. However, the damaged acreage is marginal compared to the total planted area. Rice farmers in the affected areas will be eligible for financial assistance of 1,340 baht per rai (\$252 USD per hectare) for paddy planting but no more than 30 rai per household.

## **Rice Export Update**

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for September 13 –19, 2021, totaled 59,198 metric tons, down 74,686 metric tons from the previous week and down 58,504 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 117,702 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 – September 19, 2021, totaled 2,827,320 metric tons, down 1 percent from the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013 and December 18, 2016, export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FAS/BKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
