Report Highlights:

Rice export prices further declined 4-6 percent as new crop rice supplies are entering the market.

Export prices further declined 4-6 percent from the previous week, particularly for white and parboiled rice, as supplies of new-crop white rice are entering the market. Traders expect downward pressure on Thai rice prices during the harvesting period of MY2020/21 main crop rice. Presently, domestic prices of white paddy rice are leveling off to 8,600 – 8,800 baht per metric ton (U.S. \$277-283/MT). This is still 14 percent higher than the same period last year, but to a much lesser degree than the previous weeks when rice supplies were tight.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for October 5-11, 2020, totaled 110,800 metric tons, up 24,655 metric tons from the previous week and up 9,907 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 100,893 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 – October 11, 2020, totaled 3,215,029 metric tons, down 34 percent from the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, during May 1, 2013 - December 18, 2016, export data did not include 25% - 100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FAS/BKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
