Rice export prices remain unchanged at high levels due to concerns about the strength of the Thai baht.

Rice export prices remain unchanged at high levels as Thai rice exporters are concerned about the strength of the Thai baht. The Thai baht is still at the seven-year record 29.9 baht/U.S. \$1.00, compared to the exchange rate of around 31 baht/U.S. \$1.00 between June and November 2020. Meanwhile, new inquiries for Thai rice slowed down due to shipping delays caused by a lack of available containers.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for December 14-20, 2020, totaled 82,334 metric tons, down 17,963 metric tons from the previous week and up 6,034 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 76,300 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 – December 20, 2020, totaled 4,121,296 metric tons, down 28 percent from the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013 and December 18, 2016, export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FAS/BKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
