Rice export prices decreased 3-5 percent due to the weakening of the Thai baht.

Export prices of all grades of rice decreased 3-5 percent from the previous week due to the weakening of the Thai baht. The Thai baht further weakened to 35.27 baht/\$1.00, the weakest it has been since 2017, from the previous week's exchange rate of 34.82 baht/\$1.00. Demand for Thai rice was reportedly strong as Thai rice prices became more competitive, especially for white and fragrant rice. Thai white rice prices were \$4-5/MT higher than Vietnamese price, which is considerably smaller than the typical price difference of \$15-20/MT. In addition, domestic prices of Thai rice also show a downward trend, down 2-4 percent from the previous week.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for June 6-12, 2022, totaled 114,632 metric tons, up 13,421 metric tons from the previous week and up 4,375 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 110,257 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 – June 12, 2022, totaled 2,518,842 metric tons, up 76 percent from the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013, and December 18, 2016, export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FAS/BKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
