Export prices of most grades of rice fell another 1-2 percent from the previous week due to the weakening of the Thai baht and the downward price pressure from new supplies of off-season rice. The Thai baht weakened to \$1.00=36.50 baht from the previous week's exchange rate of \$1.00=36.26 baht. The new supplies of MY2023/24 off-season rice put a downward pressure on domestic rice prices, particularly for white and parboiled rice. Domestic farm-gate prices of MY2023/24 off-season white paddy rice dropped to 10,902 baht per metric ton (\$299/MT), 3 percent below the previous week. Meanwhile, in late March 2024, Thai rice exporters won 60,000 - 70,000 metric tons of Indonesia's latest tender to export 117,000 metric tons of 5 percent grade white rice.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for March 18 - 24, 2024, totaled 196,379 metric tons, up 54,473 metric tons from the previous week and up 37,579 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 158,800 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 to March 24, 2024, totaled 1,941,492 metric tons, up 55 percent compared to the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013, and December 18, 2016, the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards took over reporting authority for rice exports and at that time the export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports. Prior to May 1, 2013, and since December 18, 2016, the Thai Board of Trade has reported rice export data, which includes 25%-100% grade white rice. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
