Report Highlights:

Rice export prices increased one percent as exporters are securing rice supplies to fulfill contracted shipment despite the weakening of the Thai baht.

Quotations were not available on the week ending on April 16, 2024, as Thai businesses were closed for the Thai New Year holiday. In the week ending on April 23, 2024, rice export prices increased one percent from the week of April 9, 2024, as exporters secured rice supplies to fulfill the contracted white rice shipments to ASEAN countries. In the week ending on April 23, 2024, the Thai baht weakened to \$1.00=36.84 baht from the exchange rate of \$1.00=36.41 baht on week ending on April 9, 2024. Farmgate prices for MY2023/24 off-season white paddy rice further dropped to 10,224 baht per metric ton (\$277/MT), down 5 percent from the week ending on April 16, 2024, as new supplies of off-season rice continued to enter the market.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for April 8-14, 2024, totaled 149,507 metric tons, down 26,597 metric tons from the previous week and down 26,158 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 175,665 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 to April 14, 2024, totaled 2,447,773 metric tons, up 50 percent compared to the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013, and December 18, 2016, the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards took over reporting authority for rice exports and at that time the export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports. Prior to May 1, 2013, and since December 18, 2016, the Thai Board of Trade has reported rice export data, which includes 25%-100% grade white rice. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
