Report Highlights:

Rice export prices increased around 3 percent to a seven-year record high in response to Vietnam's temporary ban on rice exports.

Rice export prices further increased around 3 percent, particularly for white rice, to a seven-year record high in response to Vietnam's ban on rice exports. The ban on rice exports was imposed last week due to concerns about a shortage during the COVID-19 outbreak. The ban is still in place; however, the Vietnamese Government announced that the ban would be temporary. The Vietnamese Government wants to complete an inventory of its rice stocks before more rice is exported.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for March 23-29, 2020, totaled 44,154 metric tons, down 36,576 metric tons from the previous week and down 39,628 metric tons from the four weeks moving average of 83,782 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 – March 29, 2020, totaled 1,041,948 metric tons, down 41 percent from the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, during May 1, 2013 - December 18, 2016, export data did not include 25% - 100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FAS/BKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
