## **Report Highlights:**

Export prices for white and parboiled rice are still trending upward, increasing 2-3 percent from the previous week, with new inquiries from African markets and increased demand for glutinous rice from Asian markets.

Export prices for white and parboiled rice are still trending upward, increasing 2-3 percent from the previous week, with new inquiries from African markets and increased demand for glutinous rice from Asian markets. Thai baht also appreciated against the U.S. dollar to 30.98 baht/U.S. \$1.00 from the previous week's exchange rate of 31.03 baht/U.S. \$1.00. There is roughly 30 percent of the MY2020/21 off-season rice acreage left to be harvested. Furthermore, the Bank of Agriculture and Agricultural Cooperatives (BAAC) extended the acceptance period for the 2021 rice insurance program, from April 30, 2021 to May 31, 2021. The premium rates (Tier 1) range between 55 and 230 baht per rai, depending on the historical risk in that area. The insurance protection provides 1,260 baht per rai for natural disasters (i.e., flood; heavy rain; drought; storm; typhoon and cold weather; frost, hail, and fire; and wild elephants) and 630 baht per rai for pests and disease. The 2021 rice insurance production program will cover 46 million rai.

## **Rice Export Update**

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for May 3 – May 9, 2021, totaled 70,469 metric tons, down 16,214 metric tons from the previous week and up 12,813 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 57,656 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1 – May 9, 2021, totaled 1,073,890 metric tons, down 30 percent from the same period last year.

**Note on data:** Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013 and December 18, 2016, export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FAS/BKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
