Export prices of white rice increased 7-8 percent from the previous week despite a further weakening of the Thai baht.

Export prices of white rice increased 7-8 percent from the previous week despite a further weakening of the Thai baht. The Thai baht continued to weaken to 34.33 baht/\$1.00 from the previous week's exchange rate of 34.08 baht/\$1.00. There continues to be strong demand for white and parboiled rice in Iraq and African markets. Thai rice prices are approximately \$34-37 higher than Vietnamese white rice and \$34 higher than Indian parboiled rice. Farm-gate prices of white rice paddy increased to 13,450 baht per metric tons (\$395/MT), up 4 percent from the previous week but down one percent from the same period last year.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding Hom Mali fragrant rice) for April 18-24, 2022, totaled 95,133 metric tons, up 59,819 metric tons from the previous week and up 11,799 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 89,334 metric tons (Table 2). Rice exports from January 1-4, 2022, totaled 1,720,102 metric tons, up 88 percent from the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, between May 1, 2013, and December 18, 2016, export data did not include 25% -100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FAS/BKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
