Report Highlights:

Rice export prices remain unchanged as traders are waiting for MY2019/20 main crop white rice supplies which will enter the market in the next couple of weeks.

Rice export prices remain unchanged from the previous week due to quiet trading activities. Traders are reportedly waiting for MY2019/20 main crop white rice supplies which are expected to enter the market in the next couple of weeks. Domestic rice prices are likely to be under downward pressure as farmers will immediately sell their paddy rice onto the market after the harvest because the government has replaced the Paddy Rice Pledging program with the Paddy Rice Price Guarantee program for MY2019/20 main crop rice. Under the Paddy Rice Price Guarantee program, eligible farmers will receive compensation from the government, starting on October 15, 2019 until February 28, 2020 (Table 2), when market prices they receive from the millers are lower than the guaranteed prices. Additionally, the government discontinued an interest rate subsidy program which encouraged rice millers to stockpile paddy rice during the peak harvest in the past years.

Rice Export Update

Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding fragrant rice) for September 16-22, 2019, totaled 108,262 metric tons, up 18,005 metric tons from the previous week and up 5,091 metric tons from the four weeks moving average of 103,171 metric tons (Table 3). Rice exports from January 1 – September 22, 2019, totaled 4,555,084 metric tons, down 34 percent from the same period last year.

Note on data: Export figures since March 22, 2002, do not include fragrant rice. In addition, during May 1, 2013 - December 18, 2016, export data did not include 25% - 100% grade white rice exports as the reporting authority was moved from the Thai Board of Trade to the Ministry of Commerce's Office of Commodity Standards, which does not release official export data. FAS/BKK reports only the official export numbers available from the Board of Trade of Thailand. The reader should bear in mind these differences when comparing historical data with current data.
